

Cleaning: It is recommended your door is cleaned every month to keep it in top condition. Before cleaning your door remove all rings, bracelets and watches.

Weatherseal (gasket):

During cleaning sometimes weatherseals can become dislodged from their grooves. Simply slide them back into position to avoid damage.



IMPORTANT!

For doors fitted with a lever or pad handle, the handle must **always** be lifted to fully engage the locking system. This compresses the door in its frame and provides an efficient, all-round weather tight seal. Unless these guidelines are followed, guarantees on the product cannot be maintained.

Door Leaf	Every month	Warm soapy water Wipe dry with soft cloth		Do Not Use Abrasive cleaners or Scouring pads. High pressure or steam cleaners. Bleach. Solvent or adhesives
Door Frame	Every month	Warm soapy water	For stubborn stains use specialised PVC-u cleaner, please read the manufacturers guidelines carefully	Never use abrasive materials to clean the parts
External Glass	Every month	Warm soapy water	Finish with a proprietary glass cleaner	Use only soft cloths
Leaded Glass	Every month	Warm soapy water	Finish with a proprietary glass cleaner	Oxidisation will occur naturally over time
Handle, letter-plates, spy-holes, numbers and knockers	Every month	Wipe clean with a clean cloth and warm water with a mild detergent		Do Not Use Abrasive products or solvents such as metal polish, scouring pads acetone etc

Maintenance: Composite doors are designed to be low maintenance

Which part of door	How often	Recommended maintenance	Recommended maintenance products	Notes
Hinges	Every six months	Lubricate hinges	Light engineering oil eg. 3 in 1 or an equivalent	
Cylinder locks	Every six months	Lubricate	Teflon based lubricant	Do Not Use oil or graphite powder
Handles, letter-plates spy-holes, numbers and knockers	Every six months	Moving parts should be lightly lubricated	Light engineering oil eg. 3 in 1 or an equivalent	Particularly essential if products are used within 25 mile radius of coastal areas or close proximity to building sites or large industrial areas

For doors fitted with stainless steel furniture in coastal or harsh environments, there are proprietary spray cleaners available to remove any evidence of staining that may occur.
